

Mamata apologises after Min's jibe at Prez Murmu

'Have immense respect for Prez, warned Min against mistake'

Three days after her ministerial colleague Akhil Giri made disparaging remarks about President Droupadi Murmu's looks triggering massive outrage in parts of India including Bengal, Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee on Monday said "sorry" and informed that the erring Minister had been strongly warned against repeating such "mistake".

"I am sorry for what Akhil Giri said. I apologise on behalf of the party though the party has already issued an apology ... He has committed a mistake and we are opposing it ... he has no right to speak like that," the Chief Minister said, reminding how respectful she has been towards the President.

While referring to how he was regularly being fawned by Suwendu Adhikari the Bengal Opposition Leader, Giri had on Friday told a crowd at Nandigram that "he (Adhikari) says that I look like a crowd and that I am a half-pant Minister ... though we respect



the chair of the President ... how does the President look like."

Three days through, when the tribal districts of Bengal had seen a number of road blockades and rallies, the Chief Minister on Friday broke her silence saying, "I personally have great regards for the President who is known for her social works ... I am fond of her," even as she sounded a tad philosophical.

"When you talk of beauty it cannot be regarded from the colour of the skin or one's external looks ... beauty comes from within ... it is an inner quality ... beauty does not lie outside but inside you ... I have a great regard for the President or even the Prime Minister (Narendra Modi), or other leaders," the Chief Minister said giving, however, a faint explanation for Giri's remarks.

The Chief Minister said that though she would not support Giri and "have warned him" against a repeat "mistake", the opposition leaders should also watch out for their words.

"Every day canards are being spread to malign the Government and the State as a whole ... some provocative statements are made which are not acceptable at all," Banerjee said. The Chief Minister's balancing act is seen in terms of the influence Giri exercises in a section of voters and the sizeable tribal population of the State.

Banerjee had appointed Giri — an influential leader — and an uncle of the Opposition Leader — TMC's president of East Midnapore district after Suwendu Adhikari left that party and joined the BJP in 2021.

While the Chief Minister's delay in coming out with a statement against the Giri is explained in terms of his strong following in the district, Banerjee also had to consider the sizeable tribal population in the State that spread across the districts of Purulia, Bankura, West Midnapore, Jhargram, Birbhum, West Burdwan, Malda, North Dinajpur, Jalpaiguri and Alipurduar. The tribal population accounts for 10 percent to 19 percent of votes in all these districts.

Kerala High Court nullifies KUFOS V-C appointment

'V-C's appointment was in violation of UGC regulation'

The CPI(M)-led Kerala Government suffered yet another setback in the ongoing tussle with Governor Arif Mohammed Khan as the Kerala High Court on Monday declared null and void the appointment of K Riji John as Vice-Chancellor of the Kerala University of Fisheries and Ocean Studies.

A Division Bench consisting of Chief Justice S Manikumar and Justice Shaji P Chali in their verdict said that John's appointment was in violation of the University Grants Commission regulations and asked the Chancellor to constitute a search team cum selection committee for recommending a panel of names to the Chancellor in accordance with the 2018 UGC guidelines. The court held that the selection of John as the Vice-Chancellor of KUFOS "overlooking the UGC Regulations, 2018, cannot be sustained under law".

Interestingly, the Kerala Cabinet led by Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan had on Saturday last despatched an ordinance to the Raj Bhavan to oust Governor Arif Mohammed Khan from the post of Chancellor in the Universities in the State. Two Ministers in the Kerala Government, R Bindu, Minister of Higher Education who is also the wife of CPI(M) polit bureau member A Vijayaraghavan and P Rajeev, Minister of Industries who is the rising star in the party, had issued ultimatum to the Governor to sign the ordinance.

The petition challenging the appointment of Riji John was filed by K.K. Vijayan from Kochi. He pointed out that the appointment of John was not in consonance with the 2018 UGC regulations. The regulations required the selection committee to submit a panel of three names



to the Chancellor unanimously. However, the selection committee had recommended the name of John alone for appointment to the post. The Chancellor had later notified his appointment.

The petitioner also alleged that the selection committee did not mention the experience John had in the field of academic excellence. The selection committee had recommended his appointment without ascertaining his credentials. He pointed out that the UGC Regulations required a candidate applying for the post of Vice-Chancellor to have 10 years of experience as a professor in a University or possess ten years of experience in research and academic administrative organization. But, he did not have both of these qualifications, said Vijayan.

According to the petitioner, John had faced disciplinary proceedings at his native university, T.N. University for financial irregularities. As a result, he resigned from T.N. University and joined the fisheries university by direct appointment as Dean of Fisheries. Even his appointment as Dean was illegal, Vijayan had said in his petition. The High Court verdict comes hardly 24 hours before the CPI(M) is scheduled to lay siege to Raj Bhavan demanding the President to call back the Governor.

After bail in film screening case, NCP leader booked for assaulting woman

Awhad announces to quit Assembly

Two days after he was released on bail in a case registered against him for allegedly screening of the Marathi film 'Har Har Mahadev', Maharashtra's former Minister and NCP leader Jitendra Awhad on Monday landed in bigger trouble as the Thane police booked him for allegedly trying to outrage a woman from nearby township Mumbra.

The Mumbra sprang a nasty surprise on Awhad when they registered a case against him in the wee hours of Monday under section 354 (assault or criminal force to woman with intent to outrage her modesty) following a complaint lodged by a woman, who alleged that he pushed her while making way out of a crowd that attended an event of Chief Minister Eknath Shinde.

Fifty-nine-year-old Awhad, an MLA from Mumbra-Kalwa of Thane and is considered close to NCP supremo Sharad Pawar, was the Minister of Medical Education, Horticulture, Employment Guarantee in the erstwhile Democratic Front government headed by Prithviraj Chavan

and Housing Minister in the previous Uddhav Thackeray-led Maha Vikas Aghadi government.

Within hours after an offence was registered against him, Awhad announced his decision to resign as an MLA and handed over his resignation letter to NCP's state party president Jayant Patil.

Talking to media persons later, Awhad said: "In the past I have been slapped cases under sections 30-7 (attempt to murder) and 323 (voluntarily causing hurt), I am used to such offences registered against me. This is for the first time that a case of outraging the modesty of a woman has been registered against me. I believe it is part of conspiracy hatched against me".

On Saturday, Awhad and 11 others were released on bail a cash surety of ₹15,000 each.

It may be recalled that on November 7, Awhad and his supporters had stalled the screening of Marathi film 'Har Har Mahadev' at a multiplex theatre local at Viviana Mall.

The Varatak Nagar police had registered an offence against Awhad and more than 100 others for their protest. Subsequently, Awhad and 11 others were arrested in connection with the crime.

Baghel writes to ED against Chhattisgarh ex-CM Raman Singh's disproportionate assets

Against the backdrop of several Opposition leaders including those from Congress facing the music from central agencies like Enforcement Directorate and CBI, senior Congress leader and Chhattisgarh Chief Minister Bhupesh Baghel has written a letter to the ED against his predecessor Raman Singh who alongwith his son has amassed disproportionate wealth.

Baghel has alleged that Raman Singh's property suddenly increased so much after the Naam scam, for which he does not have any proof. It has been alleged in the letter that the Naam scam took place during the tenure of Raman Singh and a major part of the money went to Raman Singh.

Baghel has asked ED to investigate the matter, however, Baghel did not receive any reply from the agency. Congress sources said if the ED does not take cognizance of

Bhupesh Baghel's letter then he will approach the judiciary.

Top Congress leaders like former chiefs Sonia Gandhi, Rahul Gandhi, D K Shivakumar, Jharkhand CM and JMM leader Hemant Soren and other top political leaders from the Opposition side have been facing probe by the ED in recent times.

Baghel has said that the immense wealth of Raman Singh and his son should be investigated so that the people of the state can know the whole truth of the corruption.

The CM also pointed towards CM Madam (Wife of Raman Singh), CM Chintamani and said that under whose pressure the ED is not probing it against them.

It is noteworthy that the 'Naam' scam came to light in Chhattisgarh State Civil Supplies Corporation, Raipur, in which several senior officials and employees of the Raman Singh government were allegedly involved in it.

Wait for poll panel's final decision: HC to Uddhav on Sena name, symbol

Hearing a petition by former Maharashtra Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray against the Election Commission's interim order freezing Shiv Sena's name and election symbol, the Delhi High Court on Monday asked why it should not wait for the final decision of the poll panel on the dispute between the party factions.

Justice Sanjeev Narula observed that the court would ask the EC to decide the issue of allotting the 'bow and arrow' symbol in a time-bound manner and both factions can put their contention before the election panel.

Advocate Sidhant Kumar, appearing for Election Commission, said that it was a constitutional body and a specific timeline to arrive at a decision may not be directed.

Senior counsel appearing for the rival faction leader Eknath Shinde claimed that there was no need for the High Court's interference at this stage when the "(interim) direction has worked itself out" after the conclusion of the Andheri East assembly bye-poll and now the "ball is in the Election Commission's court".

The Election Commission (EC), in its October 8 interim order, had barred the Shiv Sena factions led by Thackeray and Shinde from using the party name and election symbol in the Andheri East assembly bye-poll.

Justice Narula observed that the court would ask the EC to decide the issue of allotting the 'bow and arrow' symbol to one of the factions in a time-bound manner while noting that the two competing groups were given separate election symbols by the EC to contest the bye-polls.

Atrocities against Dalits shameful, says Mayawati

National president of Bahujan Samaj Party and former CM of Uttar Pradesh Mayawati expressed concern over the incident with Dalits in Rae Bareilly. She asked the government to take strict steps and check atrocities against Dalits. Mayawati tweeted about the Rae Bareilly incident on Monday morning.

Couple jumps before train after families oppose relationship

Facing opposition from their families, a teenage couple allegedly committed suicide by jumping before a speeding train in Auraiya district early Monday morning.

Surprisingly, the two had eloped about a month back and their families were searching for them, and a complaint was also lodged.

As per reports, the police were informed that a youth and a girl committed suicide by jumping in front of a train near Rasulpur railway gate of Palwal.

Both were later identified as residents of Baholpur village in Auraiya.

Woman raped in name of 'halala' in Shahjahanpur

A woman was allegedly raped in the name of halala after being given triple talaq by her husband in Shahjahanpur, according to a police official.

The official said that a court had ordered registration of the FIR following which the probe was initiated into the incident. He assured the arrest of the culprits in the incident and said that the investigation would be carried out on a scientific basis.

"A case has been registered after the order of the court and investigation has been undertaken. The medical examination of the woman was conducted. Her statements were recorded in court. They would be arrested and interrogated," Superintendent of Police at Shahjahanpur, S Anand said on Monday.
